## **GNOSTIC PRINCIPLES**

- 1. Gnosticism comes from the Greek word gnosis meaning knowledge
- 2. There exists a mysterious or secret knowledge reserved for those with true understanding, leading to the salvation of the soul
- 3. The God and Father of Jesus Christ is not the same being as the Creator-God of the Jewish faith but exists *prior to* and *above* the Creator-God.
- 4. This physical universe is a mistake, a corrupt and meaningless deception, and obliges its destruction
- 5. An individual finds True Salvation, not in freedom from the guilt of sun, but in freedom from ignorance through an intimate experience of the Divine, which is intensely personal and subjective
- 6. Jesus told Judas where to send the soldiers to arrest him, nullifying any sort of betrayal (gnostic gospel of Judas).
- 7. 4. There is a 'divine spark' or light within every person, this is in contradiction to the Bible. Verses 2 Corinthians 6:14 Isaiah 8:20. Only accepting the messiah gives you light.
- 8. Knowledge is reserved for the select few, in direct contradiction to the Bible that says the gospel is for every person (Romans 1:16).

## Versus Orthodox Principles of Faith

These principles represent less a matter of specific beliefs, but indicate true belief

- Creation of a Biblical canon using only a limited selection of early Christian writings, now called the New Testament, including Hebrew Scriptures, the Old Testament, the combination of which is the authoritative Scripture.
- 2. Adherence to the Rule of Faith as a trustworthy summary of the larger story the New Testament teaches
- 3. A church community led by a hierarchical clergy who safeguard the true teachings of Jesus and his apostles
